## **Years 3 – 6**

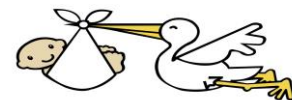
Children who receive free school meals in KS2, can also receive free milk, however this will not be automatically supplied unless requested at the office.
