## The Gospel Luke 16:1-13

One day Jesus was talking to his disciples about choosing to put God first in their lives – about not becoming a ‘slave’ to the love of money, but rather using money in a way that is pleasing to God. Jesus said: “If you can be trusted with little things, then you can really be trusted with big things. To God, money is a little thing. If you can’t be trusted with that, how can you be trusted with real riches? The choice is yours, but you cannot be the slave both of God and money.”

This Sunday’s Gospel reminds us about the value of being trustworthy people. We can show this by making good choices.
