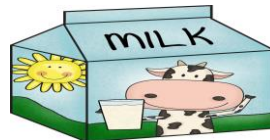
Bank Holiday Monday

KS1 Parents

We would like to remind all parents in KS1 that when the bell is rung you must line your child in their form line and stand back. Parents must not walk around with their children. Parents need to wait and if you are late you will be asked to leave your child at the red gate, to avoid this please be at school for 8.50am so your child can line up with their class.



School Milk

If you would like your child to receive milk daily, you need to pay £11.50 by Friday 28th April 2017. This will cover the cost of the milk until the Summer break.

Children in nursery, reception and those children

on free school meals will receive free school milk.

Years 3 – 6

Children on free school meals in KS2, can also receive free milk, however this will not be automatically supplied unless requested at the office.

If your child is not on free school meals you need to pay **£11.50 by this Friday 28th April for them to receive milk.**



Karate Club Years 4, 5 & 6

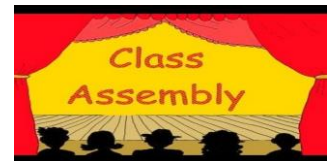
There are some places available in our Karate Club for Years 4, 5 & 6 only.
