Wednesday Word

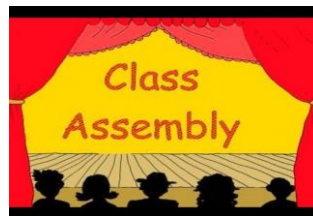
The Wednesday Word will follow tomorrow.

Class Assembly

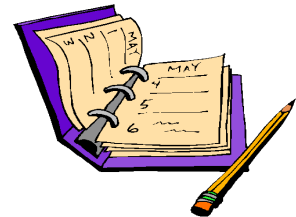
On Friday 30th June at 9.15am in the junior hall class 1/2RH (Mrs Hairsine) will hold their class assembly. Parents are welcome.
