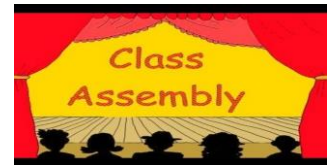
## Karate Club Years 2 to 6

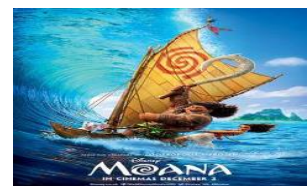
## E- Safety
