School Milk

If you would like your child to receive milk daily, you need to pay £13.50 by Friday 6th January 2017. This will cover the cost of the milk until the Easter break.

Children in nursery, reception and those children on free school meals will receive free school milk.

Years 3 – 6

Children on free school meals in KS2, can also receive free milk, however this will not be automatically supplied unless requested at the office.

If your child is not on free school meals you need to pay £13.50 by Friday 6th January for them to receive milk.



Uniform

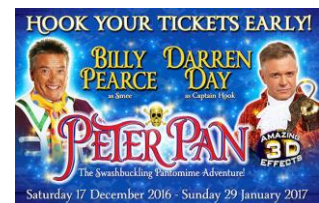
The children are looking very smart in their school uniform. A reminder that the uniform is plain black shoes or trainers; and plain, un-patterned tights for the girls.

Important Information regarding school meals

We have been advised by Facilities Management after a review of the school meal prices that the school meal price will change from 1st January 2017.
