£1 per person. No pushchairs/prams allowed inside. If brought these must be left outside at your own risk. **No ticket no entry.**



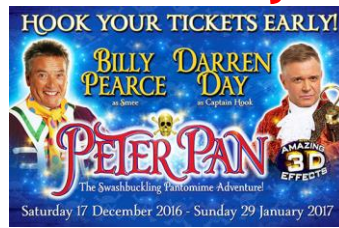
Important notice!
