Pantomime

The children from Reception through to Year 6 are invited on our yearly trip to the pantomime to see Cinderella at the Bradford Alhambra this **Thursday 25th January 2018.**

After the Panto the children will not walk back to school

- they need to be picked up from town. The Reception and KS1 children should be picked up **at 4:30pm** from beside the Cenotaph (the war memorial between the Alhambra and the Media Museum.) KS2 pupils should be picked up at the same time from outside the old Odeon cinema. In order to ensure the safety of all the pupils, the children will not be let out of the theatre if parents are surrounding the side doors.

Thank you for your co-operation in making sure that this is an enjoyable and safe occasion.

The children will be walking to the Alhambra so all children must wear sensible shoes and a waterproof warm coat. The cost of the trip will be **£7.50** per child; this has been subsidised by school.

There are still some children who have not paid. Payment is required immediately.

Receipt of payment will be accepted as your permission for your child to attend.

The school nursing team will be doing drop-in sessions at school every other week for any queries and questions. The session will be on this Thursday 25th

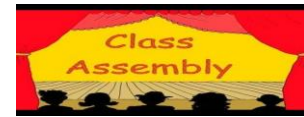
Jan 2018 then every 2 weeks in the community room 8.30am – 9.30am.
