

## ICT Level 5

I can create a series of instructions and I know I need to be clear when writing them and get them in the right order. I know sensors can be used to monitor and measure different things. E.g. I can set up a light sensor to monitor light or sound and I can describe how they are used in real life and give examples.

I can share information and ideas in different ways including using email. I can use ICT to organise information to present information in different ways for different purposes and audiences. E.g. I can make a powerpoint that includes hyperlinks so a user can navigate it themselves. I can show that I have thought about the needs of my audience.

I can talk about my knowledge and experiences of ICT and how I have seen it used outside school. E.g. I can talk about the fact that different websites give us conflicting opinions and how we can use other sources to check facts.

I can review what I have done, predict what will happen based on my decisions. I can describe how effective my work is and discuss its effect on others. I can use my reflections to improve my next piece of work. E.g. I can show my un-finished work to others and incorporate their suggestions.

I can choose the information I need for different tasks, check it is accurate and organise it so I can use it in different ways. E.g. I collect information from the internet check it against books and then make a table of my findings.
