Bradford City penalty shootout Monday 16th April 2018

Bradford City FC Community Foundation will be visiting our school to carry out a sponsored penalty shootout on 16th April 2018. The shootout will involve children asking family and friends to sponsor them to take four penalties against the Bradford City FC mascot Billy Bantam. Children who raise £3.00 or over will receive a Bradford City medal. Children who raise over £10.00 will receive a Bradford City pump bag and a medal, and children who raise £20.00 or more will receive a Bradford City leather football and a medal. Children must have their sponsorship forms with them on the day of the shootout, so they can be signed by the Bradford City staff to confirm completion. All funds raised will be split 50/50 between school and Bradford City Community foundation and all prizes will be provided by Bradford City. Prizes will only be handed out after all sponsorship forms and money have been handed in.
