Full attendance is always important, and is particularly important for the children in Year 2 and Year 6 this half-term when they will be preparing for and taking their end of Key Stage tests.

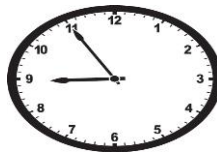
Year 2 will be taking their tests throughout May and Year 6 during the week beginning 14th May.
