Next Wednesday 25th April class RAK, Reception class (Miss. Kusar) will hold their class assembly in KS2 hall.



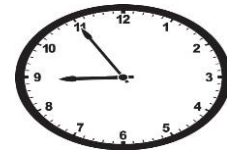
Class Mass
