We would like to congratulate Mrs Mason on the safe arrival of her baby boy Avery George who was born yesterday 2nd July.

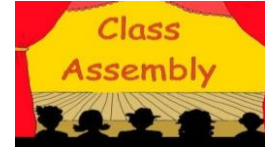
