Attendance Awards

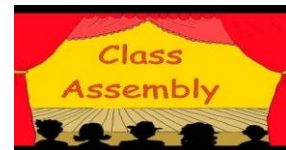
Congratulations to Class Ash 2HK on winning last week's KS1 attendance with 100% and 6LF Elm on winning KS2 Attendance with 99.42%.
