Dear Parents and Carers,

We are really pleased to have welcomed our pupils back into school this week.

This letter explains how we will continue to provide work for your child if they are not able to come to school because:

1. They are self-isolating due to a household member displaying symptoms of Covid-19.
2. The child is displaying symptoms of Covid-19.
3. You have been told that your child has been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19

If this happens, then your child will be able to access all of their learning on the **Seesaw app**. This app replaces ClassDojo. You can download the Seesaw app for your smart phone or your tablet. You can access it on a laptop using the following address <https://web.seesaw.me/>.

Your child will be able to watch videos of lessons that have taken place and complete the work that they would have done in school using the app. Teachers are able to provide a range of feedback on Seesaw so the work will be viewed and marked as soon as the teacher has the opportunity – teachers may still be teaching in school so pupils may need to act on feedback the following day. We will provide a user guide for parents so they can support their children's learning at home.

In order to access Seesaw learning activities you will need a laptop or a tablet and a Wi-fi or a fixed broadband connection. If your child is unable to attend school, and you do not have access to these then please contact us on the email address below.

If your child is self-isolating and is feeling well, we do expect that they are completing their online work each day. Your child will receive a letter containing their own unique learning code and instructions on how to access Seesaw.
