Congratulations to Class 1/2HK ASH on winning last week's KS1 Attendance with 98% and 6LF ELM on winning KS2 Attendance with 98%.



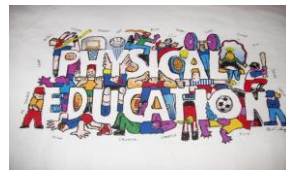
Tuck Shop
