NOTIFICATION OF NEW SCHOOL MEALS PRICES FROM JANUARY 2019.

I am writing to remind you that in keeping with previous years, an autumn term review of the school meal prices has been undertaken. The outcome of this review is that, from the 1st January 2019, the recommended school meal prices will be as follows: £1.80 per day per child £9 a week.
