



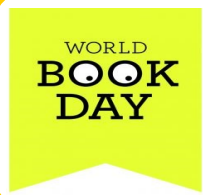

This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lent.

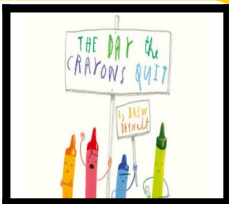
Pope Francis has asked that we take the time in Lent to being personally committed to and involved in "the building of a better world".

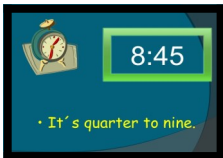
