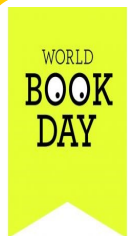

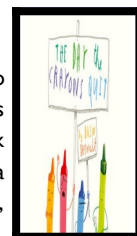


During Lent, there will be worship with Miss James in the Community Room on Thursdays at 8:30am. Everyone is welcome to attend.
